



SILHOUETTE PORTRAIT


The Eighteenth Century

YOU WILL NEED:


- Fairly dim room with bare wall
- BRIGHT flashlight
- Large (11x14") white paper *(works well)*
- Masking tape
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Pantograph
- Black paper
- Off-white colored paper
- GLUE
- Table/workspace
- 2 Buddies
- Paper Frame (optional)
- Or leave un-framed if you want to frame it later in a real frame.

INSTRUCTIONS


★ You did it! Now get those scissors and cut it out




★ Glue your silhouette onto off-white paper.



★ Frame it! Or don't!



★ Use pantograph to reduce image



LEFT HAND PERSONS: CHANGE PENCIL AND
POINTER POSITIONS AND ALSO PAPER AND
PICTURE POSITIONS!

★ Now switch so that your buddies have a turn!
