Application for Election to the George Washington Endowment Fund Board

- 1. Applicant must be a member of the National Society, Sons of the American Revolution (NSSAR), a George Washington Fellow, and current with any pledges made to the George Washington Endowment Fund (GWEF).
- 2. There are seven positions on the GWEF Board. Three of the positions are appointed by the President General: Chairman of the GWEF Board, Chairman of the GWEF Distribution Committee, and Chairman of the GWEF Fund Raising Committee. Four members are elected from the pool of GW Fellows. Elected members serve for a period of four consecutive years. One elected member leaves the board each year and one member is elected each year so as to maintain the full complement of four elected members. Any person going off the GWEF Board is eligible to apply for re-election.
- 3. An application for election may be submitted by or for any GW Fellow who agrees that, if elected, he will serve the four year term; will attend the Fall and Spring Trustees meetings and the Annual Congress each year; and will abide by the rules for attendance (absence from more than three scheduled meetings may result in loss of GWEF Board position).
- 4. An Applicant must (a) provide his name and signature at the bottom of this page to signify his willingness to serve, (b) provide a brief written statement as to why the Applicant wants to sit on the GWEF Board, and (c) provide a NSSAR resume or biography.
- 5. The names and supporting documentation for all Applicants must be received by the Chairman of the GWEF Board at least one month prior to the published start of the Annual Congress.
- 6. The names of accepted Applicants shall be disclosed at least three weeks before the Annual Congress convenes vie electronic communications such as broadcast email and SAR-Talk (Officers).
- 7. Election from among the announced Applicants shall be conducted during the GW Fellow Luncheon at the Annual Congress. Each Applicant (or his representative) is offered one minute of time to state his qualifications.
- 8. Votes are counted by appointed Tellers immediately after ballots are collected and the results will be announced on the day of the vote.
- 9. The successful Applicant takes office at the next scheduled GWEF Board Meeting after the Congress.
