The park is located off I-95 at Exit 366 then head west 2.8 miles on Pecan Park Rd. to 2145 Arnold Rd./ Gold Star Family Parkway to the Park. You can also access the Park off Lem Turner Rd. to Lannie Rd. to the new Gold Star Family Parkway past the Jacksonville National Cemetery.
