


goes as planned, she will also graduate as a new member of the DAR! Welcome aboard, Madison!

This national genealogical research library houses over \$5,000 letms, including family histories, local, country and state records. The Library also provides access to the SAR special Collections containing both institutional archives and Revolutionary period items. The online castalog allows you to see what is a voyed with many titles connected to digital or e-book editions that can be accessed through their corresponding catalog record - just look for the "E-book" designation, and click on the link four within the exampled rathorin record.


